

FAQs

1. Question: What kind of health and sanitation procedures are in place to make my Skatemobile event safe?

Answer: We put health and safety at the top of our priority list for all events. In addition to having trained staff members at your event to make sure that everyone is enjoying themselves, while maintaining a safe distance, we have the following policies in place:

- guests are required to wear masks. For those guests who forget their own mask, we will have one-use masks available for free, and RCR masks available for purchase.
- When it is time to gear up, attendees will find that our RCR staff has laid out their pre-specified skates and gear, with distance between each kit and physically-distanced gear-up and gear-down.
- Our coaching team has identified a list of activities that hosts can choose from, all of which allow for 6ft of distance between attendees, and are tons of fun to boot!

2. Question: How long will Skatemobile be at my location?

Answer: Your event includes 30 minutes of prep time, plus two hours of on-skates fun.

(Our World Glampions Package provides for an even longer skating time, with event lengths customizable for any occasion!)

3. Question: What counts as a “flat surface”?

Answer: There is nothing like feeling the breeze blow past you while roller skating outside. However one big crack in the sidewalk can cause even the most experienced skaters to slip! As the host of a Skatemobile Party, you are required to pick a location for your event that has a flat surfaces for skaters to roll on. Surfaces include (but are not limited to) school gymnasiums, tennis courts, parking lots, garage spaces, basketball courts, and cul-de-sacs. Not sure if your location is flat enough?
